He states he enlisted in Maryland in 1776 in Captain John Smith's Company (The 4th Regiment). His wife, aged 56 and 2 daughters, are living with him. He served in the 4th Regiment and later transferred to the Second Maryland Regiment under the command of Col Ford. He served from 1776 to August 1883 when he was discharged by Col. Brumby. He fought in the battle of Brandywine, Germantown, Camden, Guilford Courthouse and Eutaw Springs. He was shot in thee hip during the last battle. Walter Hagan [also a soldier in the Revolution; cf. below] made oath that James Hagan was in the war for six or seven years, and he was in service as late as 1781; warrant s-36003.
