Matthew 22:15-22

¹⁵Then the Pharisees went and plotted to entrap him in what he said. ¹⁶So they sent their disciples to him, along with the Herodians, saying, "Teacher, we know that you are sincere, and teach the way of God in accordance with truth, and show deference to no one; for you do not regard people with partiality. ¹⁷Tell us, then, what you think. Is it lawful to pay taxes to the emperor, or not?" ¹⁸But Jesus, aware of their malice, said, "Why are you putting me to the test, you hypocrites? ¹⁹Show me the coin used for the tax." And they brought him a denarius. ²⁰Then he said to them, "Whose head is this, and whose title?" ²¹They answered, "The emperor's." Then he said to them, "Give therefore to the emperor the things that are the emperor's, and to God the things that are God's." ²²When they heard this, they were amazed; and they left him and went away.

Prayer.

The moral high ground is a dangerous claim to stake for once the flag is planted the secure foothold of every certain man and woman is lost. As tentative and noncommittal as walking on newly cleaned ice even the most confident fall hard in the arena of public scrutiny. Even honest Abe had enough backwoods Calvinism to admit the ambiguity of the righteous cause.¹

Social uneasiness Social dis-ease The Gospel pries us out of our comfortable easy chairs from our smug party affiliations to question in our hearts the competing claims of Caesar and Christ.

If it were only as simple as we claim it to be-With indignation we cite Jefferson as if he were a god while in the same breath extend him pity for his moral failure of keeping slaves all-the-while acknowledging the evil of slavery's horrific institution. "I tremble" he proclaimed when facing the darkness of death "when I remember that God is just."

"We know that you are sincere" the tormentor argues insincerely concealing behind his words a probing desire for malice and murder. "We know you teach the way of God according to the truth" the hypocrites hype hoping the Savior steps into the trap

Truth? Truth is, the hypocrites would be the last to know the truth even if it smacked them square in the face. Disciples of darkness the Pharisee pledge class know much about what truth isn't but the deceitful never have a clue about what freedom truth can become.

Irony produces a coin while the Savior remains penny less.

Money belongs to man but God is greater. Money can't buy you a ticket on redemption's bus. Money won't bribe the matre'de at heaven's doorstep. Money means nothing to the One who created the world in 6 days and rested on the 7th.

The image of the King stamped on worthless metal bears no comparison to the image God imprinted upon us on the day of our creation.

The claims of state become indifferent to a Gospel that defines the moral high ground to a Savior who loves with every atom of His composition and with every piece of His divinity. The claims of state become irrelevant to a God who calls and claims all who will listen and follow.

"Separation of church and state" may be the gold that pays for a civil society free of tyrants and terrorists but in the end it becomes nothing more than paving material for our Lord's heavenly streets.

Have you not heard? Salvation does not come from the Law. Salvation does not come from party affiliation. Salvation does not come from the left or from the right. Salvation does not come from the employer, the banker, the teacher, or the preacher. Salvation does not come from the bench, the oval office, or from the halls of congress. Salvation does not come from Social Security. Public Assistance, weapons of war, or a FEMA response. Salvation does not come from the family, the toys, or all the petty attempts to build our own little kingdoms.

Salvation comes from the Lord! Faith in the Lord's salvation trumps any hand Caesar may hold. Salvation comes from the Lord! Bought and paid for by the blood of the lamb. Salvation comes from the Lord! In Thee do we place our trust.

When the flag passes by when the lever is depressed in the booth when asked to support policy, plank, or party -be careful! Don't give to the state that which ought to be given to God! I can not and will not tell you exactly where that line needs to be drawn. My faith my hope my trust is in the Lord that He will give you all the grace necessary to make the right decision.
