The Oglala Commemoration Committee is seeking candidates for the Leonard Peltier Scholarship. This scholarship is geared towards meeting the financial needs of the nontraditional student. *The applicants must have a General Equivalency Diploma (GED), this school year and currently reside in the local geographic area*.

This scholarship was created to honor Leonard Peltier's vision of empowering the Oglala people to have an active part in defining the future direction of the tribe. The intent, all have the potential to rise above their circumstances and to contribute to the preservation of Traditional Lakota language, culture and spirituality through education.

The qualifications to apply for the scholarship are listed below.

If you find that you do qualify, we invite you to complete the application.

ELIGIBILITY:	Applicants must have a GED Diploma and registered at Oglala Lakota College as a freshman. Students must be tribally enrolled in the Oglala Sioux Tribe. The student must attend or plan to attend the Oglala Lakota College.
AMOUNT OF AWARD:	The amount awarded will be paid directly to the Oglala Lakota College.
	This is a ONE-year scholarship for \$250.00.
CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:	Average academic performance (2.0 GPA or equivalent). Extra-curricular participation Community Service References: -two personal -two community related -one academic (teacher, principal or counselor)
APPLICATION:	Complete an application, which includes your personal background, college goals, a personal vision, and a statement of why you should be awarded this scholarship.
OTHER:	The Individual(s) receiving this scholarship must agree to share their experiences/accomplishments with at risk youth in the tribal community.
PROCEDURE:	Submit application, recommendations, and transcripts by 4 pm Sept. 10, 2004, to the address printed below: "Submission".
