UNSTANDARDISED CLASS

This class is for new breeds that have been granted a 'working title' from the Australian National Cavy Council Standards Review Panel, but do not yet have a recognised standard accepted by the ANCC.

JUNIOR EXHIBITOR CLASSES

Cavies must be exhibited/owned by a junior member (under 18 years of age). Entries are restricted to one entry per class and **must also be entered in the respective General Class.**

NOVICE CLASS (at table shows only)

The Novice Class is for 'novice' exhibitors (in your first 12 months of membership). It is a 'beginners' class to learn how to exhibit and prepare their cavies for the show table. The animals are judged on grooming/preparation and handling. Exhibitors are advised on the finer points of showing. This class is only at table shows. Cavies must be exhibited/owned by a NOVICE member.

PET CLASS

The Pet Class is for non-specific breeds of cavies. Members or non-members may enter. Cavies entered in General Classes are not eligible to enter this class. Cavies are judged on care, condition and temperament.

ENTRIES

To be sent on the correct entry form and posted to the Entries Secretary listed on the show calendar, before the closing date. Some Entry Secretaries may take email entries. See page 2 of *Cavy Capers* for details.

SHOW TIME

The hall will be open from 9am. Ear tags to be collected and fees paid by 9.30am.

At **table shows**, General Class judging commences at 10am. Junior Exhibitor, Novice & Pet Classes at 11am.

At **Agricultural Shows** cavies are displayed in pens (pen shows). Arrive from 8am. Junior Exhibitor judging commences at 9.30am.

General Class judging commences at 9.30am. All cavies are to be penned by 9am and remain on show until 5pm or a time otherwise stated by the relevant show society.

EXHIBITION

No Judge or the immediate family of the Judge may exhibit at a show at which they are judging. A cavy purchased from a judge, may not be exhibited under that judge until a period of 3 months has elapsed.

At **pen shows**, carpet squares 30cm X 30cm are required for each cavy, for the exhibition pens.

At **table shows** all cavies must be exhibited on a show board (or similar) – height not to exceed 5cm.

No talking is permitted at the judging table. Any communication must be left until after the judging of that class has concluded. Any exhibitor making comments about other animals may risk their animal being disqualified. The judge's decision is FINAL and no correspondence will be entered into.

CONDITION OF ENTRY

All exhibitors must be financial members of the NSW Cavy Club, Inc. or an ANCC affiliated club; with the exception of entry to the Pet Class.

All shows are held under NSW Cavy Club, Inc. Regulations; each exhibitor is bound to abide by these regulations, which are available from the Secretary; or the Club website. ☺

ENTRY FEES

Members: All Classes: \$5.00 for the first entry and \$1.50 for each cavy thereafter.

Late entries: double the normal entry fee.

Note: Please give full details of breed and/or colour on your entry form. Classes marked with * will be split when 2 or more cavies of the same colour or variety are entered.
