About the NSW Cavy Club, Inc.

Aims of the Club

Formed in 1969 by Mrs Wynne Eecen, the AIMS OF THE CLUB are to (1) Upgrade the status of cavies generally (2) Breed good quality cavies to Australian National Cavy Club Standards (3) Provide information to the public concerning the nature and care of cavies.

Shows

Held regularly throughout the year at halls and selected agricultural shows. The major shows are the Sydney Royal Easter Show and the annual National Cavy Show, where cavies from all states are shown. Classes are held for adult Boars and Sows; Juniors (6–9 months) and Babies (3–6 months). There are also classes for new members (Novice Class), which are judged solely on the care of the cavy and classes for young members – up to age 18 (Junior Exhibitors).

Varieties

There are a number of recognised breeds of cavy which are shown. Cavies are divided into seven Groups: MARKED, SATIN, SELF, CRESTED, TICKED, COARSE COAT and LONGHAIR.

Stud Registration

Stud names are registered with the Australian National Cavy Council to avoid duplication of names. *The Australian National Cavy Council Book of Standards for the Exhibition Cavy* is available to download from the ANCC website: <http://ancc.asn.au>.

Library, badges and supplies

The Club lends books and magazines to members. Club badges, stickers, entry forms, schedules, and cavy care articles are available from the Secretary.

Newsletter

The Club newsletter, *Cavy Capers*, (10 issues per year) advises members of Club activities and contains articles of interest to the cavy fancy. It has a free advertising service for members wishing to buy and sell animals and equipment.

Stud Ads

Appear in the newsletter and are a service for members, who may supply artwork of their own or have them designed by the Editor.
