- 2. The BREAKFAST COMMITTEE is responsible for receiving (from the previous breakfast committee) and replenishing chapter supplies such as coffee, coffee cups, napkins, sugar, etc. The BREAKFAST COMMITTEE is responsible for setting up and cleaning up for breakfast for the weekend.

- 4. If you need extra help serving meals, etc., please let the Hospitality VP know.
